Get to Know Keynote

Presentations button

This is where you create new presentations and find the ones you've already made. As you work, Keynote automatically saves your progress.



Get to Know Keynote

Toolbar buttons

Use these tools to add photos, tables, charts, and shapes. Change fonts and text size. Edit Presenter Notes, add animations, and play your presentation.



Get to Know Keynote

Slide Navigator

The Navigator shows every slide in your presentation. From here you can arrange them any way you like. Tap the Add (+) button to add new slides.



Get to Know Keynote

Arrange slides


To reposition a slide, tap and hold it, then drag it to a new location. To select multiple slides, tap and hold one, then tap more slides with another finger.



Get to Know Keynote

Duplicate slides

Select a slide, then tap it again to see the menu. Choose Copy. Tap and choose Paste.



Get to Know Keynote

Undo your work

Shake your iPhone or iPod touch to undo your most recent action.



Working with Objects

Add and edit text

Double-tap to select the text to the right, then begin typing.

When you're finished, tap the Done button in the toolbar.



Working with Objects

Copy and paste



Select an object, then tap Copy. Tap anywhere to deselect the object, then tap the background and choose Paste. You can drag the pasted object wherever you like.

Working with Objects

Move, scale, and rotate



Tap and hold the object, then drag it to a new position. To resize it, drag the selection handles. To rotate, tap and hold the object with two fingers, then turn.

Working with Objects

Add objects to this slide


Tap the Insert button. Choose shapes, text, charts, tables, or your own photos.



Working with Objects

Apply styles


Select an object to the right.
Tap the Info button. Then
choose a style.



Working with Objects

Edit the chart

Tap the chart to select it. Then choose Edit Data to reveal the Chart Data Editor. From here, you can edit your data using the onscreen keyboard.



Animate your Slides

Enter animation view

Tap the Tools button. Then tap Animation Mode. Touch a slide or object to animate it. When you're finished, tap the Done button in the toolbar.



Present your Work

Play your presentation

Tap the Play button in the toolbar. Then, tap once or swipe left to advance to the next slide. Swipe right to return to the previous slide. Try it now to see some of the dramatic transitions in Keynote.





Magic Move

Create sophisticated animations using the same objects on two slides. Change the position or size of the objects, and Keynote automatically animates them from one slide to the next.



Object Builds


You can animate any object on your slide using build animations. Tap anywhere on the slide to view examples below.



Wrap it Up

Exit play mode

When you're finished presenting, simply pinch anywhere on the slide.



Sharing your Work

Easily share your presentations


You can share your presentation in an email, or via iWork.com public beta so anyone on a Mac or PC can view it on the web. Tap the Tools button. Then tap Share and Print.



Working with Presentations

The Presentations view

Tap any presentation to open it. Tap the new (+) button to create a new presentation. To select a presentation to share, duplicate, or delete, tap the Edit button, then tap a presentation.



Organizing your Presentations

Creating folders

To organize your presentations into folders, touch and hold any presentation, then drag it on top of another.



iCloud

Keep your presentations up to date

iCloud stores your presentations and keeps them, and any changes you make, up to date across all your devices.
